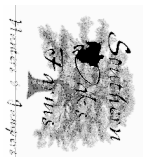

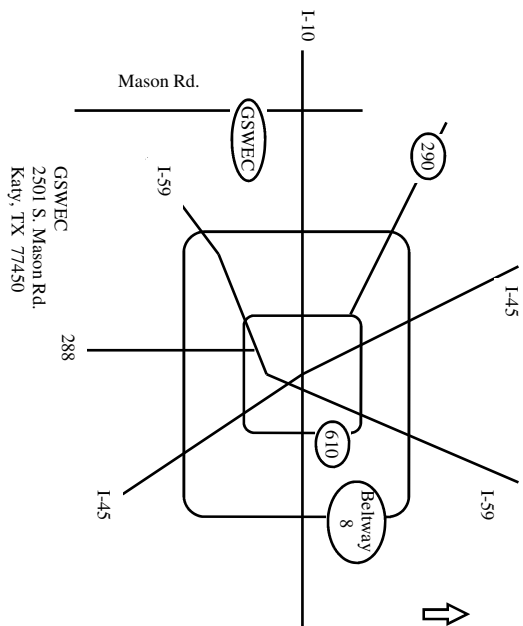

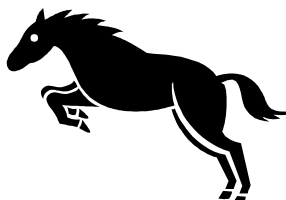

Medals will count for 2009

- *84. Pony Medal. Open to GHHJA member pony riders. Not to be divided by size. Fences 2' for small, 2'3" for medium, 2'6" - 2'9" for large. Three riders must complete the course for points to count at year end. Two or more USEF test 1-9 of the top four riders will be required.
- *85. Limit Medal. Open to GHHJA member Limit riders. Fences 2'6" max. Three riders must complete the course or points to count at year end. Two or more USEF tests 1-9 of the top four riders will be required.
- *86. GHHJA Medal. Open to Junior or Adult Amateur GHHJA members. 2 or more USEF tests 1—19 will be required of the top four riders. Three riders must complete the course. Fences 3'.

Stabling: \$75.00 weekend
\$45.00 overnight (arriving after 4 p.m. the previous day & showing 1 day only)
\$40.00 day stall (arriving & showing same day)
Stabling fees must be pre-paid to guarantee stalls.
Each stall MUST have at least 1 bag of shavings purchased.

Grounds Fee: \$22.00 per day for all horses not stabled

Office/Medic Fee: \$10 per entry per show day

Schooling: After noon on Friday and Saturday & Sunday until 15 minutes before start of ring

Schooling Fee: \$15.00 per day for horses not showing

Effective 12/1/05 USEF ruled that protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards and carries the SEI tag is required for all riders while mounted on horses on the show grounds. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

WARNING

Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

All minors must have parent/trainer or guardian sign an entry release. In all classes except for Warm-Ups, riders must wear shirts with collars and either boots and breeches or paddock boots and jodpurs in order to show. GHHJA points will not be counted toward annual awards until membership dues have been paid and horses have been recorded with the association. All riders and trainers of entries in this show must be members in good standing of GHHJA, or pay non-member fees. Horses & ponies competing for year-end awards must be registered, and their owners and trainers must be members. Membership dues are \$30 for seniors (age 18 & over), \$25 for juniors (under the age of 18), and horse/pony registration is \$20.00 (lifetime) or \$5.00 (annual). Dues must be paid to show secretary or proof of membership & horse/pony registration must be submitted before showing. **A NON-MEMBER RIDER OR NON-MEMBER TRAINER MAY PARTICIPATE AFTER PAYING THE SHOW SECRETARY A "NON-MEMBER FEE" OF \$10.00 PER ENTRY PER SHOW DAY.** Leadline participants are exempt from non-member fees. New horse registration: The owner of a horse/pony registering must check the list of horses that are members and may not duplicate any name of horses already in the GHHJA database. PLEASE CHECK WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY FOR A CURRENT HORSE LIST - AVAILABLE IN THE SHOW OFFICE.

All classes have 6 ribbons. Champion & Reserve in each division.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes or to do anything necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

***LIMIT HUNTER**

For riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons over fences at any GHHJA/THJA/USEF (affiliated) recognized show. Beginner, Novice, or Schooling Hunter ribbons do not count against this division. Blue ribbons won in Pony Division at THJA/USEF do count toward eligibility; however, blues won in the Pony Division at GHHJA do not count towards Limit eligibility. Riders eligible at the beginning of the show year remain eligible all year. Fences 2'6".
