Negative EIA Certificate dated within one year.

Health Certificate: **A Health certificate dated within 14 days of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds.** Your horse health paperwork must be pre-copied and ready to leave at the check-in office upon arrival or email to info@gswec.com. Thanks!

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

ENTRIES

Entry closing date without incurring a late fee is **Thursday, March 5th, 2026**. Entries can be completed at www.horshowsonline.com. Please make your RV and Stabling reservations at our website, www.gswec.com.

COMPETITION NUMBERS

OFFICE ISSUED NUMBERS must be worn in the competition rings.

SCHOOLING

All rings will be open for schooling on Friday from 12:00 pm until 6:30 pm. Entry blanks must be signed before schooling. No manual poling; no offsets of any type may be used while schooling. Jumping will be permitted Saturday and Sunday until 30 minutes prior to show time and after the show only when medical personnel are on the grounds. Schooling is free during posted hours and schooling after posted hours are at your own risk.

ATTIRE/HEADGEAR

All riders must be properly attired (shirts with collars and either boots and breeches or paddock boots and jodhpurs). Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

Protective head gear must be worn BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED, anywhere, anytime on the showgrounds. Headgear for all riders must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness. Protective headgear is required for all riders while mounted on horses on the showgrounds. Junior exhibitors must wear a harness hat approved in accordance with 2023 USEF rules. Effective 12/1/2022 the ruling also applies to adults whether riding on the flat or jumping and when jumping is required (including schooling and warm-up rings.) Any rider violating this rule at any time will be prohibited from riding until head gear is properly in place.

OFFICE FEE/LATE FEE

A \$35 Office fee will be charged per entry per show day. Any disputes with your bill must be made within 30 days after the after the last day of the horse show. **All entries received after 6 pm, Thursday, March 5th, will pay a \$35 late fee.**

STALL FEE/ GROUNDS FEE/ NON-SHOWING FEE

12x12 and 10x10 permanent stalls (with doors) are available at a cost of \$110 per weekend. Overnight stalls at \$90 (arriving after 4 pm the previous day and showing one day only). Day Stalls at \$60 (arriving and showing same day). Ship-ins will be charged a \$60 ground/clean up fee per horse per day. Each horse will be charged a \$10 Schooling Fee. Non-Showing Fee will be charged at \$60 per day. Horses showing both days will be charged a weekend stall. All stalls will have a minimum of (2) bags of shavings per stall added to the bill. **NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED. If outside shavings are found user will be fined \$500/stall.**

GHHJA MEMBERSHIP FEES

All riders and trainers of entries in this show must be members in good standing of GHHJA or pay non-member fees. Horses and ponies competing for year- end awards must be registered, and their owners and trainers must be members. Membership dues are \$275 for lifetime membership, \$45 annual for seniors (age 18 & over), \$40 annual for juniors (under age 18), Owner/Parent/Other annual \$35 and horse/pony registration is \$45 (lifetime) or \$15 (annual). Dues must be paid to show secretary or proof of membership and horse/pony registration must be submitted before showing. *Duplicate horse/pony names are not allowed. **A non-member rider or non-member trainer may participate after paying the show secretary a "non-member fee" of \$12.00 per show day.** Lead line participants are exempt from non-member fees. The owner must first check the current registration list to avoid name duplication.

USHJA OUTREACH

A onetime \$5.00 USHJA Fee will be added to each horse that participates in any USHJA Outreach Classes.

Membership with USHJA Outreach is required if you wish to have your points tracked for year end awards from USHJA. **Membership applications can be done online at USHJA.org.**

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

CREDIT CARD CONVENIENCE FEE

A convenience fee of **3.25 %** of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit card.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

A \$50.00 SERVICE FEE OR 10% OF THE CHECK AMOUNT/CREDIT CARD CHARGE, WHICHEVER IS GREATER, WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS AND/OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.

CAMPERS

Camper spaces are available for \$55 per day.

MEDIC FEE

A \$15 Medic fee will be applied to every horse entered including "non-showing" horses.

RINGS & FOOTING

Mega Ring 1 is approximately 145' x 265' with ESI International all-weather footing. Mega Ring 2 is approximately 145' x 265' with ESI International all-weather footing. ESI Ring is approximately 140' x 275' with ESI International all-weather footing. Otto Sport 2 is approximately 125' x 275' with Otto Sport footing. Tellepsen Indoor Arena is approximately 150' x 250' with sandy loam footing. Main Indoor arena is 150' x 300' with ESI International all-weather footing. Wheelless Arena (East Indoor) is 125' x 250' with sandy loam footing. Footing is a priority; rings may be closed to schooling during inclement weather and/or for maintenance at any time during the show at the manager's discretion.

COURSES

Courses will be posted a minimum of 30 minutes prior to each class. In Hunter classes, fences will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as; brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post and rails, and gates. At management's discretion, a dotted line may be put into effect to restrict the size of the courtesy circle in hunter classes.

RIBBONS/ TROPHIES/ CHAMPIONSHIPS

All hunter classes receive a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. All equitation classes receive a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. All jumper classes receive a trophy and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. Each hunter and jumper section will receive a champion & reserve award based on points unless otherwise noted. See GHHJA rule book. In all hunter sections, Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to two of the top four horses acquiring the most points over fences. These four horses will also receive full points for one under saddle class.

PRIZE MONEY

All jumper and hunter stake classes are paid 1st – 3rd place. 1st = \$15 2nd = \$10 3rd = \$5

Derby and Classic prize money allocations is listed by class description. **A filled out and signed W9 must be on file in order for prize money to be awarded.** After 60 days from last day of horse show, all prize money that is not claimed with a completed W9 on file will be deemed as voluntary forfeit of prize money in lieu of a signed W9.
